

DATA ACQUISITION PROCESS

A critical part of the SIERA on-boarding process, the EVORA Data Acquisition process uses the following core principles, and ensures inherent flexibility by building on an initial mobilisation and due diligence phase:

1. Data mobilisation due diligence.

Understand the current data landscape and requirements in relation to your ESG strategy. Our team will conduct a short audit by interviewing key stakeholders and reviewing current data sources and collection processes.

2. Baseline requirements and governance.

Play back your data requirements to validate the accuracy and standardisation of data source formats, frequency of collection, level of automation and agreed governance process between key parties. An example of this is our escalation process with the Client in the event that timely supply of data from your energy data providers is not available.

3. Acquire the data.

Acquire data from the agreed sources, with basic initial quality checks and clarifications with the energy data providers and how automated data collection can be utilised.

4. Data Transition.

Cleanse and load the data into our SIERA Data Management and Analysis platform and the integration of automated feeds wherever possible.

5. Data Validation.

"Fresh eyes" validation of the data now hosted within the SIERA Platform.

6. Publish reports.

Sharing of key reports and fine tuning against baseline requirements.

7. Training and Adoption.

Training for key users in system usage and self-service.

8. Business as usual and agreed collection and reporting cycles
